takes the young enrollees on field trips to places
of interest and importance in our area. And to the
extent possible, it matches each enrollee with an
individual mentor from the ranks of the 100 Black
Men of Greater South Bend.**

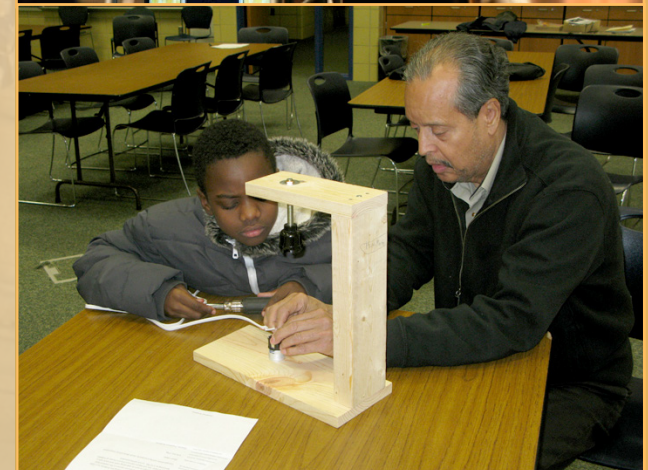
